Requirements:

Complete 2 Compete (C2C) is a Mississippi statewide program focused on assisting Mississippi adults who have completed some college, but no degree, to finish the requirements necessary to earn their degrees. The program provides applicants with a road map and the support of a personal C2C Coach/Advisor. They will find the faster pathway to a degree and provide support to help navigate the process.

C2C is designed for an adult learner who:

- has been out of college at least 24 consecutive months (based on last date of attendance),
- has completed some college-level coursework,
- is at least 21 years of age, and
- has not completed a postsecondary degree.

Adult learners who are interested must meet all of the above requirements and are required to apply on the C2C website. Once a completed application is submitted, applicants will be contacted by a Jackson State University Coach/Advisor within 5-10 working days. **\$1,000.00 grants are awarded (each semester) to those who live in the state of Mississippi who meet qualifications.**

Steps to Follow/Timelines:

Step 1:

Enter Your Information on the C2C Site

Go to the JSU website (www.jsums.edu), and click on the C2C logo/link, and enter your information and press "submit".

Step 2:

Check Your Email

Expect an "automatic" email containing your C2C Coach's name and contact information. (Normally within 24-48 hours). Always check your Spam folder.

Step 3:

Hear from C2C

A C2C Representative (not your JSU Coach) will contact you via phone within 24-48 hours to go over any questions. Within 2-3 working days after your C2C application has been electronically sent to your coach, you should receive a "1st Introduction Letter" email from your C2C Coach.

Step 4:

Request Transcript (s)

After the receipt of your first introduction letter, in 1-2 working days you will receive a second introduction letter emailed from your C2C Coach with specific details about requesting your transcript. If you are a former JSU student, please respond by emailing your Coach your J# number (only 8 digits. ie...J00123456) and other information requested. If you have never enrolled at JSU, you will need to contact all previous schools and request your official transcript (s) to be sent to JSU-Office of Undergraduate Admissions (OUA). After OUA receives and post all transcripts, your C2C Coach will start reviewing your courses and email you a "Transcript Evaluation" email with specific instructions to apply for undergraduate admissions, apply for FAFSA, and apply for MS Tuition Assistance. NOTE: Expect to receive your "Transcript Evaluation" via email from your Coach within 5-15 working days after all transcripts have been received. The Office of Undergraduate Admissions sends the admissions decision email.

Step 5:

Find Your Fastest Path

A. If you need a few more credits, your C2C Coach will help you find the fastest path and connect you with the resources needed to complete your degree. You will enroll at JSU, complete the remaining classes needed, and finish your degree. (On-line or Face to Face Classroom). B. If you are eligible for a Degree after the transcript evaluation is completed, your C2C Coach will connect you to the appropriate department to "apply for graduation".

Step 6:

Get Your Degree

You will be issued a degree (after all requirements are satisfied) and be ready for a better life and brighter future.
